Local Emergency Management encourages you to sign up to receive alerts on your cell phone.





Hurricane Harvey completely devastated our little City which has taken many of us years to restore the damages left behind. The City Hall reconstruction Bid went out for procurement in August of 2021 and the contract was awarded by the City Council to BASCO, INC.
