The City of Pine Forest is a council form of government. The City Council is comprised of a Mayor and 5 council members. Elections are held for all councilmembers in odd years, with the mayor and councilmembers each serving two-year terms. All powers of the city are vested in the City Council, which enacts local legislation, adopts budgets and determines city policies. Council is also responsible for appointing the city attorney, the city secretary and all other city staff.



... and remember to set your clocks back one hour on November 7, 2021.


City Hall Under Reconstruction


In the next coming days, our city hall will be under reconstruction from Hurricane Harvey. Please be patient with us during this time.

Hurricane Harvey was a devastating Category 4 Hurricane that made landfall in August of 2017. Hurricane Harvey completely devastated our little City which has taken many of us years to restore the damages left behind. After years of operating in a temporary building next to our City Hall, we are excited to announce that we have finally moved back into our original City Hall building. Although, there is still much work to be done, it's one step forward in the right direction. The City Hall reconstruction Bid went out for procurement in August of 2021 and the contract was awarded by the City Council to BASCO, INC.
